



2009 Tax Table

Donations to United Way result in a charitable tax credit that reduces the amount of Federal and Provincial income tax payable. Donors receive a Federal tax credit of 15% on the first \$200 of charitable donations, and 29% on donations above this amount. Similarly, donors receive a provincial tax credit of 5.06% on the first \$200 of a charitable donation and 14.7% on donations above this amount.
